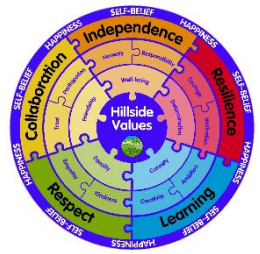

Maths:

Can show 'finger numbers' up to 5 and 10

Recite numbers past 5

Experimenting with symbols and marks



Understanding of the World:

Shows interest in different occupations

Develop positive attitudes about the differences between people

Explores how things work

Talks about he/she sees, using a wide vocabulary



Personal, social and emotional development:

Talks about his or her feelings

Developing a sense of responsibility

Communication and Language:

Enjoys listening to longer stories
