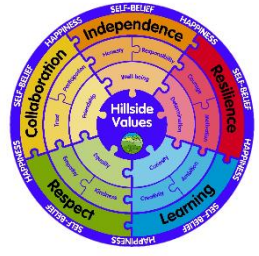


Year 3

English:
