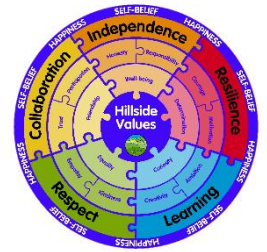


Year 4



Spring

English:

In English we will be focusing on narrative writing linked to the Romans. We will be taking inspiration from the books *Escape from Pompeii*, *Roman Invasion* and *Empire's End*. Additionally, we will be focusing on Y4 SPAG including subordinating conjunctions, fronted adverbials and direct speech

PE:

We will be going swimming and Mr Hughes will be working fitness and developing handball skills.

RE:

In RE we will be learning about Humanism. We will be looking at what Humanists believe is important and how their beliefs might impact choices they make in their lives.

DT:

Children will use sewing skills to design, make and evaluate a Roman Bulla.

History:

We will be learning about Britain before and after the Roman Invasion. This will draw comparisons between Celtic life, the Roman Empire and their influence on our lives today.

What did the Romans teach us?

Art:

We will be studying a range of sculptors, with a view to creating our own realistic Roman inspired bust using clay.

Music:

We will be learning to play the trumpet, understanding the history and heritage of the instrument, building up to performing a simple song

Maths:

Following White Rose, we will be focusing on:

- Multiplication
- Division
- Measure and perimeter
- Fractions
- Decimals

Science:

We will be learning how sound is produced, how it travels and how we hear different sounds (pitch and volume). We will apply this knowledge to create our own musical instrument. We will also learn about the digestive system and teeth answering the question 'What happens to our food?'

Computing:

We will be learning how to be safe when using computers, especially when online. We will then develop our coding knowledge using scratch.

French:

We will be learning: the days of the week, numbers 0-20 and bi-lingual dictionary skills.

Home learning:

An assignment will be on Teams each week set on Friday due in the following Thursday.

Children are expected to read 5 times a week and record this in their Home Learning Journals.

We strongly encourage children to use TTRS every day to practice for the Multiplication Tables Check that all Y4 pupils will sit in June.
