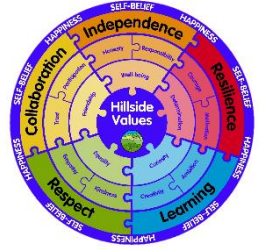




Year 6



Spring

English:

We will be exploring writing units based on our reading texts, 'When Hitler Stole Pink Rabbit', 'Goodnight Mister Tom' and 'Anne Frank'. We will be drafting and editing narratives, writing biographies linked to Science and creating diary entries based on events of the Reading bombing in WWII.

RE:

We will be exploring two key areas this term:

1. Christianity- Is anything ever eternal?
2. Christianity- To examine the influences others have on us.

DT:

Inspired by 'Make do and Mend' during wartime Britain, we will be using sewing skills to create a bag for an evacuee.

Home learning:

Daily Maths homework will be given each day due for the following day. Spellings will be set on EdShed and an assignment will be on TEAMS each week set on a Friday due in they following Thursday.

History:

We will be learning about life in World War 2. We will use a range of primary and secondary sources to learn how life in Reading and wider Britain was affected by wartime events.

How did events during WWII influence life in Britain then and now?

Geography:

We will be using 8-point compass directions for navigation. We will use a range of sources of information, such as maps, photos and diary entries, to investigate the locations of bombings in Britain during WWII.

Art:

We will study the work of Henry Moore and create artwork using charcoal and crayon, inspired by his 'Shelter drawings' based on his time in the London Underground during the Blitz.

Music:

The pupils will sing songs from WWII. We will study the lyrics of Vera Lynn's 'We'll meet again' and prepare a performance.

Maths:

Following White Rose, we will be focusing on:

- Fractions
- Percentages
- Decimals
- Algebra
- Geometry

Science:

We will continue to explore electricity and how we can be greener. We will also learn about evolution and explore how animals and plants are adapted to the environment in which they live. Our key scientists will be Charles Darwin, Mary Anning and Katherine Johnson.

Computing:

Pupils will learn how to use Microsoft Excel to organise data in different ways. We will then move on to Bletchley Park and discover all about coding.

French:

We will be learning the vocabulary for different pets and members of the family. We will be using j'ai and je n'ai pas in sentences.
