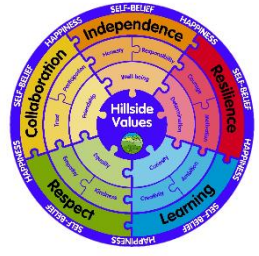


Year 3
