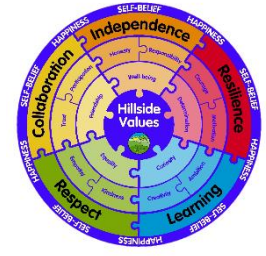


Year 5



Summer

English:

In Summer 1 we will be writing explanation texts about animals, then developing our letter writing skills.

In Summer 2 we will be writing adventure stories inspired by our reading, then creating poetry and leaflets about South America.

PE:

Outdoor – Handball, cricket, rounders and tennis.
Athletic field and track events in preparation for Sports Day.

RE:

We will be exploring two key questions this term:

1. What is the best way for Sikhs to show commitment to God?
2. What is the best way for Christians to show commitment to God?

DT:

Home learning:

An assignment will be on Teams each week set on Friday due in the following Thursday.

History:

We will explore the rise and fall of the Mayan civilization and discover what Mayan life was like. We will consider the legacies that can be seen in the UK today.

Geography:

Pupils will develop their locational knowledge using globes and world maps, before looking at the physical geographical features of rainforests. We will learn about commodity chains and Fair-Trade food during a trip to ASDA.

Art:

In Summer 1, we will be drawing flowers and developing printing techniques.

In Summer 2 we will be using Modroc to sculpt our own 'Alebrijes'.

Music:

We will be developing our skills on recorder, and listening to composers from the Romantic period.

Maths:

Following White Rose Maths, we will be learning about:

- Properties of shape
- Position and direction
- Decimals
- Negative numbers
- Converting units
- Volume

Science:

We will be focusing on living things throughout summer term, including plants, animals and the human life cycle.
